Materials List



Staff paper (can print from Visual link)

Music writing or notation supplies - pencil/eraser, plastic/paper circles that fit between staff lines, or white board with dry erase marker

Hearts with rhythms written on them (quarter, eighth, and half notes, and quarter and half rests) OR Heart Rhythm digital activity provided through link

Candy or 4 wrappers and tape OR Candy Wrapper Composition digital activity provided through link
Quiet signal (object that makes a sound that your child responds to - totally optional)

Game supplies - small object (key or button) to pass or hide, timer (Here We Sit), scarves if playing Great Big House as group game (optional), yarn and key (Closet Key) if playing as group game
Movement props (optional) - scarf or scarves or streamers

Instruments - rhythm sticks, (wood block optional), hand drum, metal instrument (triangle), shaker or scraper instrument (maraca) These can be homemade or objects around the house.

Barred instrument with mallets - glockenspiel is the smallest, virtual is free
